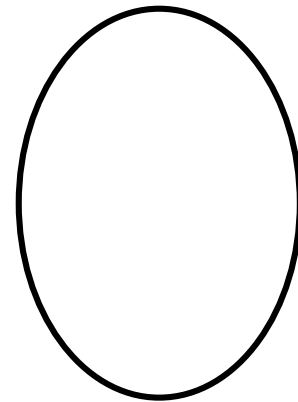
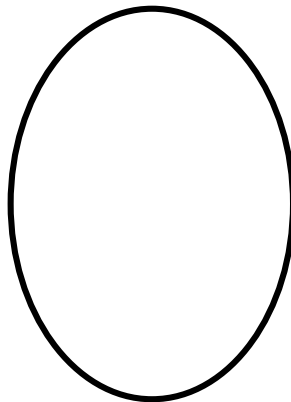
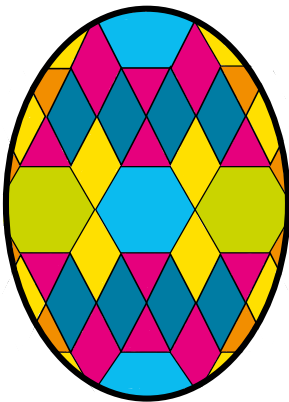

Easter egg wrappers often have symmetrical patterns. They sometimes use mathematical shapes to make the patterns.

Can you design an egg wrapper using different shapes and colours – make it symmetrical!
