

Numberblock Ten bottle rocket

You'll need

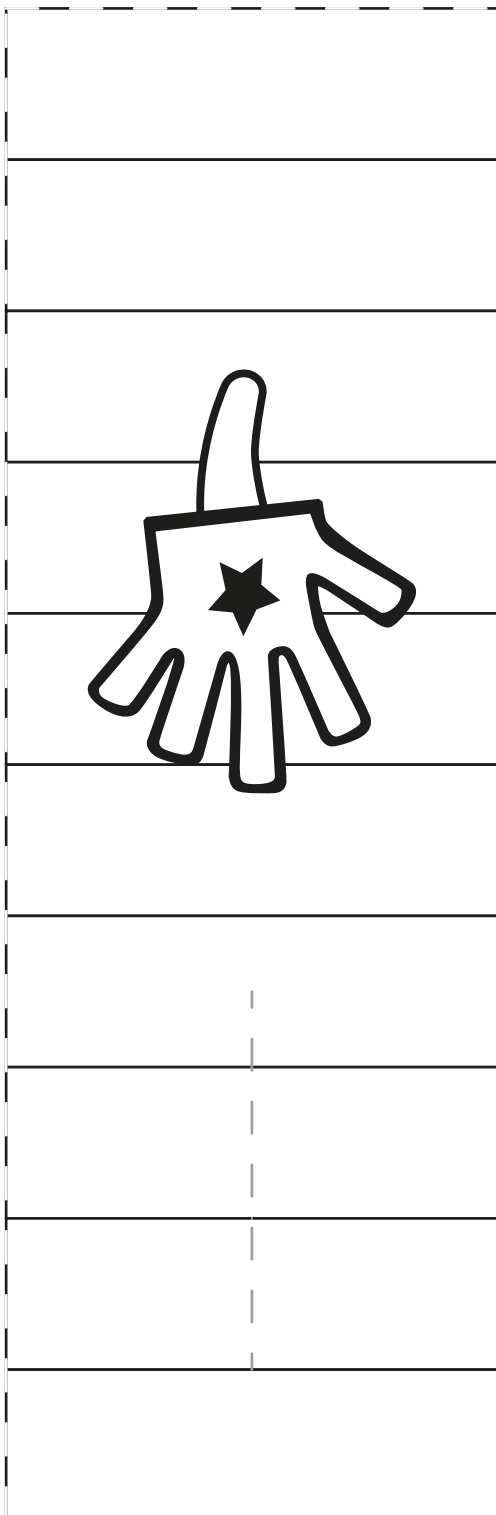
Plastic bottle - roughly 25cm high
White ready mixed paint
Red, pink and grey pen
Glue
Scissors

Instructions

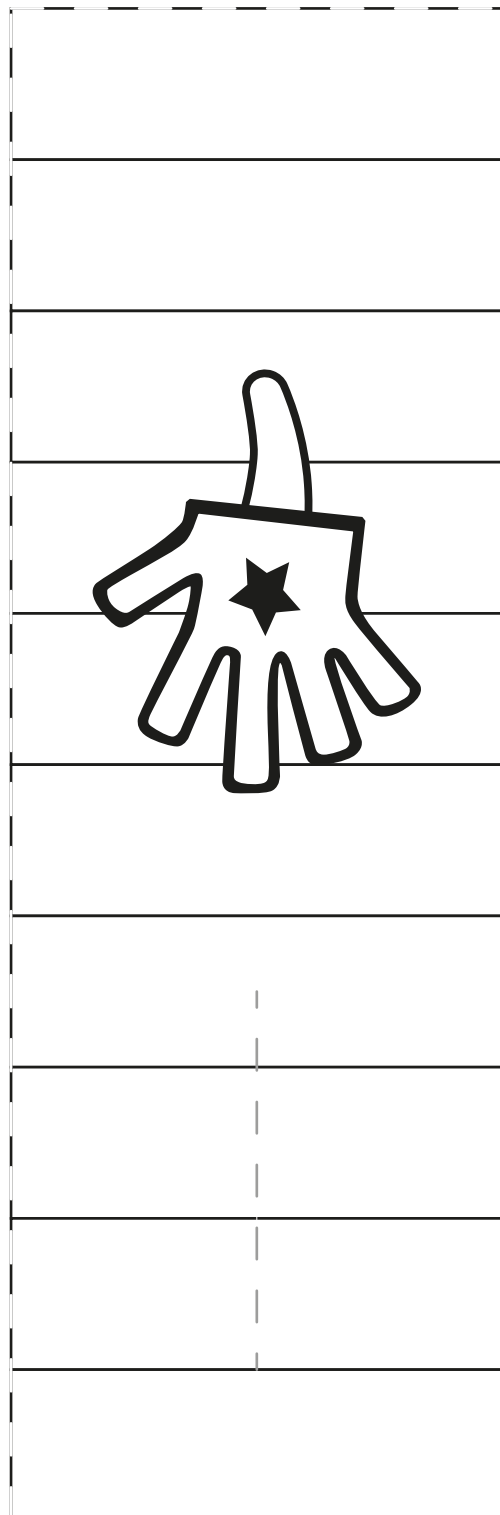
- 1 With a grown-up, pour some paint into the bottle. Place the lid on and shake to completely cover the inside.
- 2 Colour in the templates, then snip them out. Don't forget the slits on the side panels and rocket wings.
- 3 Push the rocket wings through the slits in the side panels and glue them to the sides of the bottle.
- 4 Draw grey lines on the front and back of Numberblock Ten to mark out her 10 blocks.
- 5 Fold and glue together Numberblock Ten's helmet. Push the helmet onto her head and glue on the legs.
- 6 You're ready to blast off on a space adventure with your fantastic Numberblock Ten bottle rocket.

Tip: Mix some PVA glue with your paint to help it stick to the plastic bottle.

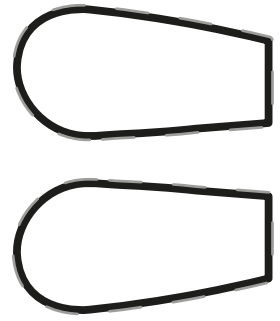
