How does the school support families' literacy and numeracy skills so that they can effectively help their child?	
Do families who are not living with their children get regular updates about what's happening at school?	
Do families know that members of the extended family can get involved in their child's education?	

Are schools working together to help families at key transition points throughout their child's education?	
Are there links with other agencies that can support families in supporting their child's learning? For example the local libraries, community centres or community learning teams.	
Do families know about local resources that they can access?  How is this information made available to them?
