

	Numbers can be intimidating, but that's okay. Nearly a third of Brits say they struggle with everyday maths, while over a quarter say they have struggled to understand the numbers relating to the Covid-19 pandemic. However, pointing to the vital role employers can play, over two-fifths (42%) say if their workplace offered help to improve their numeracy confidence and skills, they would give it a go. This is why, between the 1 <sup>st</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> of November, we are joining the charity National Numeracy in encouraging the nation to take part in 'Number Confidence Week'. For this year, the campaign is focused on three key themes: - How number confidence is key to managing your money - Why boosting numeracy skills can help take the fear out of the maths you need for work - How to develop positive attitudes around numeracy to better support children with their maths homework As part of Number Confidence Week, National Numeracy are streaming a 'Confidence Conversations' series around these three themes, with celebrities, experts and real learners talking about why feeling better about maths opens the door to brighter futures at work, home and school.
